Goals and Objectives

The expenditures listed in the following goals and objectives are pursuant to meeting the projected revenues in the budget. Therefore, it may be necessary to prioritize the expenditures based on the success or failures of fundraisers.

- Modernize the playground and to have all equipment up to code
 - Temporarily improve the fall zones on the playground area to 6 inches. Add a barrier to contain the mulch.
 - Create a basketball area which will include lines for 4 square, hopscotch, etc.
 - Remove wooden pieces and replace with newer, durable structures.
 - Create an outdoor learning classroom.
 - Install a water fountain/source outside.

- Promote Family Involvement
 - Host three classroom parties.
 - Host eight After School Celebrations.
 - Develop and distribute PTO Newsletter.
 - Hold monthly meetings.
 - Maintain Parent/Family Center within the building.

- Support student exposure to community experiences
 - Provide financial assistance towards Field Trip Experiences.

- Promote and support reading enrichment both at home and at school
 - Purchase one book for every child at Christmas.
 - Extend the Accelerated Reader Contract.

- Support Science Education
 - Provide Financial Support to host WV Farm Bureau at JRES - Fall 2016.

- Support Staff and Student Morale
 - Recognize and provide a gift to each JRES student who participates in Forest Festival Court.
 - Plan and organize activities to recognize Staff Appreciation.
 - Promote activities that encourage and reward positive student behavior and achievement.

- Maintain a School Outdoor Beautification Project
 - Plant flowers in pots/beds.
 - Purchase and Spread Mulch in flower beds as needed.
 - Trim trees and shrubs as needed.

 - Provide support towards the Fifth grade Party.
 - Provide financial support towards the cost of a yearbook for each fifth grade student.
