

## Kindergarten Activity Grid Days 11-15

\*Read 15 minutes daily with your child

\*Practice sight word list or sight word rings 10 minutes each day

\*Practice math facts or counting 10 minutes each day

\*Choose one activity from each column below each day. Initial the activity chosen.

Reading	Soc. St/Science	Math	Writing
Make a list of rhyming word pairs. Ex. Dog-frog Cat-bat	Find a wildflower, such as a dandelion, in your yard. Dig it up, draw and label the different parts of the plant.	Play before and after number games. Ex. What number comes before 12? What comes after 18? What number comes between 21 and 23.	Write a question to ask your family. Write the answer they give you in a sentence. Ex. Is it spring? Yes, it is spring. Keep it simple.
See how many words you can make with the word Spring.	Draw what you want to be when you grow up and tell an adult about your picture.	Use an egg carton and figure out all the number pairs that make 12.	Write and draw about your favorite indoor activity.
Play I Spy with letters of the alphabet. Ex I spy with my little eye something that begins with b.	Play a board game.	Draw an Easter egg and decorate it with drawing two dimensional shapes.	Write and draw about your favorite outdoor activity.
See how many words you can make from the word Easter.	Draw a picture of your neighborhood and label it.	Use different size crayons, pencils or straws and line up from shortest to tallest and tallest to shortest.	Write sentences describing a bunny.
Pick a letter of the alphabet and see how many words you can name that start with that letter in two minutes.	Draw pictures to match different feelings.	Using number flash cards ,draw two numbers and choose which number is greater or less. Can use it as a game to see who gets the most cards.	Write sentences describing the weather.
Sing your Secret Stories alphabet song.	Draw a picture of your favorite family activity.	Practice counting on from different numbers.	Write sentences using color words.
Play memory using sight words.	Draw about your favorite holiday.	Make up addition and subtraction stories.	Write sentences using number words.
Use letter cards to build and read words.	Draw a tree for each of the four seasons.	Trace your handprint several times and count by 5's.	Write what you miss about school.
